Wilderness Survival package (all ages)

- Children arrive at the woods and after an initial safety brief work together to build a simple A-frame shelter they will need to survive Storm Stanley.
- They will have approximately 45 minutes to make their shelters storm proof before Storm Stanley heads their way in a thunderous cloud of wind and rain.
- If the children have survived Storm Stanley they will have a short break for lunch and birthday cake before heading to the top of the woods.
- Here they will work together to build and manage small fires before Storm Stanley heads back through and drowns the fires out.
- After all this hard work the children will retire to the main campfire for a storm debrief and popcorn before retiring to the vehicles and leaving the storm wash lands.
