



## SCHOOL TRIPS

Typical activities for themed session may include:

### Stone/Iron Age

- Traditional shelter making
- Cave painting
- Pewter smelting for arrow heads and jewellery
- Flint knapping & pottery
- Using bow, arrows and 'atlatl'
- Traditional fire lighting with flint and steel.

### Ancient Greeks

- Design and build a giant Greek Catapult/Trebuchet!
- Mini Olympics - Javelin making and throwing practice, make crowns for winner's ceremony!
- Test and Fire Trebuchet

### Arctic Exploration

- Collect resources for the day and transport by sledge to camp
- Assemble Arctic Tipi, water, wind and snow proof
- Fire challenge – traditional fire lighting- how hot our tipis will get
- Team ski shoe challenge

Or just come along for a day of bushcraft and survival skills and team games and challenges! Days can be tailored to meet your individual requirements.
